Evolution contractual basis for cultural ties, as a factor in the revival and development of culture ethnic minorities: trends (1990 – 2000-s)

The article is based on archival, statistical and analytical developments predecessors examined the role of cultural ties in the revival and development of culture ethnic minorities and on this basis intensification of ethnic identification, to ensure harmonization of interethnic relations. The literature that includes the problem of the cultural heritage of the Ukrainian people only partially considers the problem of foreign and domestic factors Recovery and Development Culture ethnic minorities.

The importance of the described problem is determined, above all, the need to have a clear idea of how the solution of an independent state interethnic relations. It is shown that during the study in Ukraine gradually lined up a system of international treaties and agreements which lacked character bilateral cooperation in terms of efficient use and development of a common cultural heritage.

Take into account the factor of continuity and perspective in the development of new contractual basis for cultural ties. Much attention is dedicated to political factors to facilitate the expansion and deepening of cultural relations.

For the first time in the historiography on the basis of specific methodological tools of analysis conformity external political factors - strategic objectives - recognition of the ethnic nature of Ukrainian society, the development of socio-cultural environment and spiritual development of ethnic Ukraine. Particular attention is dedicated to participation in establishing the foundations of cultural ties of state and government of Ukraine and countries appeared to ethnic homeland ethnic groups. Emphasized that international treaties on good-neighborliness, friendship and cooperation were legal political basis for the formation of qualitatively new system of cultural cooperation. A significant part of the article dedicated to discovering find stories - effectiveness of bilateral cultural contacts in the right balance to ensure national - cultural interests. Also identified the most effective and promising form of good relations between Poland, Bulgaria, Czech Republic, Hungary and Slovakia. The features of the return of cultural property, cultural exchange, cross-border

cooperation. Investigated problems analyzed from the perspective of promoting the study of political understanding and establishing productive contacts in the spheres of ethnic groups.
